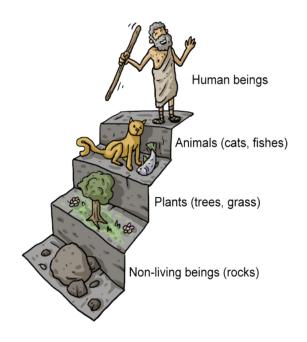

<u>Education committee</u> - We are working on a handbook related to starting an Esoteric Healing practice and business. Once this is finished it will be available for free on the NAEH website. We are also exploring possibilities for offering online classes in the future and identifying what topics and content would be appropriate for this type of learning.

## **All About Arthritis**

As Esoteric Healing facilitators we will inevitably come in contact with people who have various disease processes or conditions. Although we do not treat or diagnose these conditions, it is in the best interest of both the client and ourselves to be familiar with some of these ailments. In this column I will be taking a look at some of the more common conditions that we may see in our practices and exploring them from both a physical and metaphysical perspective.

#### Arthritis -

You have probably heard the word "arthritis" before and the chances are that you will see someone in your Esoteric Healing practice that has this condition. By definition, arthritis means "joint inflammation," and it's used to describe more than 100 different diseases and conditions that affect joints, the tissues that surround joints, and other connective tissue.

Arthritis can affect people differently. It's common in adults 65 and older, but it can affect people of all ages, races, and ethnic groups. In fact, about 1 out of every 5 adults in the United States — around 50 million people — has reported being diagnosed by their doctor with some form of arthritis.

Two of the most common forms of arthritis are osteoarthritis and rheumatoid arthritis. Osteoarthritis: Often called "wear and tear" arthritis, osteoarthritis (OA) is the most common form of arthritis in the U.S. In most cases, over time, cartilage in joints breaks down, and painful symptoms begin to occur. OA is most commonly found in the knees, hips, hands and fingers and spine. Typically, OA comes on slowly. For many, the first signs are joints that ache after physical work or exercise. As the disease progresses, other most common symptoms include: painful joints, stiffness after periods of inactivity, and swelling or tenderness in one or more joints.

While the exact cause of OA is unknown, joint damage can be due to repetitive movement (also known as "wear and tear"). It can also begin as the result of an injury. Either way, with OA there's erosion of the cartilage, the part of the joint that covers the ends of the bones. Some factors that may increase the risk of developing OA are age, gender, obesity, joint misalignment, and heredity.

**Rheumatoid arthritis** (RA) also causes painful joints but it is actually an autoimmune disease where the body's immune system attacks normal joint tissues, causing inflammation of the joint lining.

This inflammation of the joint lining can cause pain, stiffness, swelling, warmth, and redness of the affected joint. The affected joint(s) may also lose its shape, resulting in joint deformity and loss of normal movement. If left untreated, RA can worsen and destroy ligaments and joints. RA is an ongoing disease, with active periods of pain and inflammation, known as flares or flare ups, alternating with periods of remission, when pain and inflammation disappear. The exact causes of RA are unknown. But research has shown that several factors may contribute to the development of RA such as genetics, infection, and environmental factors.

#### Metaphysical possibilities -

Authors Louise L. Hay (Heal Your Body), Dr. Douglas Baker (Esoteric Healing, part 2, Stress Disorders), and Dr. Christine Page (Frontiers of Health) all suggest that rigidity of thought, inability to adapt to change, resentment, being in a rut, and feeling victimized and powerless can be related to the development of arthritis. Dr. Douglas Baker also adds that self-repression, self-denial, and self-martyrdom can also be seen in many people who suffer from arthritis. Caroline Myss, in her book The Creation of Health, notes that in a study at Harvard Medical School individuals who had trouble coping were likely to have raised levels of rheumatoid factor in their blood which is closely associated with the development or presence of rheumatoid arthritis.

#### **Nutritional considerations -**

Many people have found that vegetables in the nightshade family such as potatoes, tomatoes, eggplant and peppers can aggravate arthritis. This can also be said for processed foods, especially sugar. A diet high in whole foods and low in sugar can be very helpful for people suffering from arthritis.

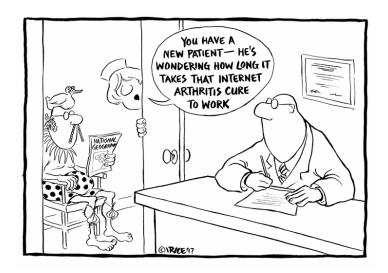
#### **Esoteric Healing considerations -**

In addition to assessing the entire energy system for areas of restriction and imbalance and treating accordingly, the focus of treatment would also include the Basic, Heart and Throat centers.

The Basic center relates to bones and is a core treatment for the spine. The Throat center relates to expression (both verbal and creative), listening and being heard, lymphatic system (important with any areas of swelling) and the connective tissues of the body including tendons, ligaments and cartilage. The Throat center is also resonant with Ray 3 which is so important in allowing the person to move into adaptability and releasing rigidity of thought. The Heart center is important in the treatment of all autoimmune diseases such as rheumatoid arthritis.

### Some suggestions for treatment include:

- Balancing affected centers at all levels, especially emotional and mental
- Spine treatment; with Basic, Alta major and Throat centers; adding Ray 3 for Alta and Throat
- Throat center + affected joint + Ray 3
- Lymphatic system + Ray 3
- Voice and ear triangles, at all levels + Ray 3
- Expression (service) triangles + Ray 3
- Thymus triangle and Immune system treatment

## **Exciting News for Esoteric Healing!**

Esoteric Healing classes, Parts 1 through 4, have been approved to be taught at John F. Kennedy University in Pleasant Hill, California. Each class will provide 28 continuing education credits to fulfill licensing and professional development needs for Registered Nurses, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Licensed Clinical Social Workers.

JFK University Continuing Education (CE) for Esoteric Healing is approved by:

- The California Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) to provide continuing education for registered nurses (provider #02354).
- The California Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) to provide continuing education for MFTs and LCSWs (provider #PCE 3555).

The Esoteric Healing classes will be offered as stand-alone CE courses and are open to the general public.

At this time the following classes will be offered in JFKU's 2016 Spring/Summer schedule:

- An Introduction to Esoteric Healing Part 1; April 21-24, 2016.
- Integration Part 2; August 11-14, 2016.

- Enable clinicians to provide better psychological care to clients.
- Be evidence-based and clearly supported by substantiated research within the field of psychology.
- Describe the accuracy and utility of the information presented, the basis of such statements, the limitations of the content being taught, and the severe and most common risks.
- Experiential components must expand upon the theories covered and allow participants to practice or apply the techniques presented.

I believe it is because of our NAEH that this opportunity to offer Esoteric Healing classes at JFK University was able to happen. Through the NAEH:

- We are provided with opportunities for our own continued education:
  - Through Publications we are able to write and publish articles that pertain to Esoteric Healing and share them in our journals and newsletters.

## Recipe

## **Gingered Carrots & Lemon Rice**

## Healthy beginnings start here

Gingered Carrots Serves 2

- · 2 cups julienned carrots
- · 2 tablespoons freshly-grated ginger root
- · 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- · 1 tablespoon ghee
- 1/2 teaspoon Organic Vata Churna
- · Salt to taste



- 1. Parboil carrots in water with Organic Vata Churna for about 3 minutes. Remove from heat and set aside.
- 2. In a separate frying pan, heat ghee and add ginger and brown sugar. Sauté for about 3 minutes.
- 3. Add carrots and continue cooking for another five minutes.

#### Lemon Rice Serves 2

- · ¾ cup basmati rice
- 1½ cups water
- · ½ cup fresh lemon juice
- · ¼ teaspoon salt
- · ¼ teaspoon turmeric
- · 1 teaspoon black mustard seeds
- · 2 teaspoons ghee
- 1. Rinse rice and add to boiling water. Cover and simmer for 20 minutes.
- 2. In a separate pan, heat the mustard seeds in ghee until they start popping. Then remove from heat.
- 3. Let mustard seeds cool, then add lemon juice, salt, and turmeric. When rice is finished cooking, add the spice mixture and mix well. Vpk\* by Maharishi Ayurved





## Ask Auntie Karana

Q: My business partner is making decisions that negatively affect both of us and I want to try and help her find clarity through Esoteric Healing. In the past, I have done treatments on her for headaches. The idea of energy work started out as a very foreign concept for her, but the sessions really helped. Since then, she's a believer in what EH can do for the body. But I know if I ask now if she'd like a treatment with nothing physical happening, she will think it's kooky. If you have worked on someone before, do you need to have permission to do it again?



A: The answer to this is always, 'Yes, you need permission.' Esoteric Healing is only

done on a patient/client when specified by them. There are two exceptions to this: when a parent asks you to work on a child who is under sixteen, still forming on a soul level, you do not need the child's permission. And If a patient is unable to speak, you can tune in and ask for permission to work on them, but only do one thing: balance the chakras according to the will of their soul.

In the case of a business partner who is making negatively influential decisions, a discussion is much more in order than a treatment. Through a heartfelt exchange, she could even ask for healing, but do not conduct the conversation with that as a goal. Let her come to it on her own, or not.

Q: My husband and I are separated. At this point, we are not speaking and I would like to send him good energy. In the course of our history, I have done many sessions of Esoteric Healing on him and I want to know if it's okay to continue remotely.

A: Again, you need permission with every session. The work is always performed according to the will of the client's soul, and by not asking, you would be violating his will and self determination.

What you could do instead is, whenever you start thinking you can help him through EH, stop yourself and pray for the best for all concerned, without imposing a specific outcome. That is as energetically clean as you can get in this situation. Practice patience and trust and seek healing for yourself for support through this difficult time.
