# Fran's Facts: by Fran Oppenheimer RN, LMT, CPEH

As Esoteric Healing facilitators we will inevitably come in contact with people who have various disease processes or conditions. Although we do not treat or diagnose these conditions, it is in the best interest of both the client and ourselves to be familiar with some of these ailments. In this column I will be taking a look at some of the more common conditions that we may see in our practices and exploring them from both a physical and metaphysical perspective.

#### Focus on Adrenal Fatigue:

The diagnosis of Adrenal fatigue is one that is surrounded by controversy. Adrenal fatigue is a term that was actually coined by a chiropractor, James Wilson, in 1998 and is used by alternative medicine providers to suggest that the adrenal glands are exhausted and unable to produce adequate quantities of hormones, primarily cortisol, due to chronic stress or infections. There is currently no accepted scientific basis in the medical community for the existence of adrenal fatigue, and the term is not the same as a number of actual forms of adrenal dysfunction such as adrenal insufficiency or Addison's disease.

Adrenal fatigue is a term applied to a collection of mostly non-specific symptoms including:

- Ongoing fatigue
- Muscle weakness
- Loss of appetite and weight

- Abdominal pain, nausea, diarrhea
- Low blood pressure
- Depression and irritability
- Low blood sugar
- Craving for salt

To diagnose Adrenal Fatigue, alternative medical practitioners such as Naturopaths, and Chiropractors or Functional Medicine doctors may order blood or salivary testing to look at cortisol levels. They may also order test that look at the microbiome, or gut flora, for imbalances seen in adrenal fatigue. Many dietary supplements, lifestyle changes and dietary modifications have been suggested for this condition.

Whether or not this condition is recognized by the standard medical community there are many people who identify with the profile of this condition and will seek treatment from alternative health care providers and energy medicine practitioners. Most of these people suffer from bouts of extreme fatigue and physical discomfort such as muscular aching as well as sleep disturbances. There is also almost always an emotional component present in the case and many more women than men seem to suffer from adrenal fatigue. As energy medicine practitioners we recognize that the impact of emotional stress and trauma, even from the prenatal period, can have a profound effect on the health of an individual throughout their lifetime.

#### **Metaphysical Possibilities:**

In <u>The Healing Secrets of the Ages</u>, Catherine Ponder connects health conditions to emotional issues and life circumstances. According to Ponder, the adrenal glands are where the Strength center of our body is located. This is where we get the ability to "keep on keeping on" and to endure.

The adrenals are there to spur us on, to give us energy to tackle stressful situations, both emotional and physical. The adrenals—think adrenaline—are closely connected with the sympathetic nervous system (the gas) as opposed to the parasympathetic nervous system (the brake). During times of fight or flight, we need the sympathetic nervous system to change our physiology, so we can take action. We also need the parasympathetic nervous system to change your physiology, so we can benefit from deep rest and restoration.

Unfortunately, many people's adrenals are tasked with constantly producing the hormones that keep them amped up. Abnormal adrenaline and cortisol levels can result in mood disorders, sleep disturbances, reduced immunity, and changes in vital circulation. Because these side effects are not uncomfortable enough to be intolerable, a self-destructive, adrenal-depleting lifestyle often continues.

Eventually, the adrenals become overtaxed and exhausted, and can't keep up with the burden. People with adrenal exhaustion often complain of too many things to do and not enough time in which to do them. They often feel that "If I don't do it, it won't get done." This is a false sense of responsibility, and it also depletes the adrenals.

Louise Hay in <u>Heal Your Body</u> suggests that low self-esteem is related to the cycle that results in Adrenal Fatigue.

Affirmations can be helpful in changing habitual patterns of thought and belief. This can assist one to uncover a spiritual solution to physical ailments, which in turn promote true healing. One affirmation that may be useful with Adrenal Fatigue is: "I no longer resent my responsibilities. They are expanding my good in every phase of my world. My yoke is easy and my burdens are light."

#### **Esoteric Healing Considerations:**

In addition to assessing the entire energy system for areas of restriction and imbalance and treating accordingly some more specific treatment related to Adrenal Fatigue might be:

- Vagus nerve and all related triangles
- Autonomic nervous system
- Immune system
- Spleen and all related triangles
- Adrenal and Kidney triangles
- Fear and Courage triangles
- Allergy triangle
- Pleasure point triangle
- Thyroid triangle
- Thalamus
- Hypothalamus
- Pituitary
- Emotional level of everything; Emotional body treatment
- Higher centers balance and treatment of appropriate sheath(s)
- Could try holding the hypothalamus, pituitary and adrenals together (hpa axis)
- Could try holding the hypothalamus, pituitary and thyroid gland together (hpt axis)

As in all Esoteric Healing treatments follow what you find as the systems of the body are an integrated whole. The patterns and answers will reveal themselves when we go in as objective facilitators.

There are differences of opinions in the world about what is right and wrong on almost any issue. With Esoteric Healing, the use of ethics is important not only when working with the energetics of another person but in creating our part in right human relationships. This is the reason we are creating a series of short articles focusing on points of ethics that truly need to be acknowledged and discussed.

I would like to address for the next article the first ethics statement listed from the NAEH Code of Ethics for practitioners. "Demonstrate commitment to provide the highest-quality Esoteric Healing to those who seek out their Esoteric Healing care."

Reading through the list of ethics statements to write these articles, this one caught my attention and I thought of this particular client. This gentleman with whom I have been working for a number of years has made quite a gain in healing but can be a very difficult client to work with.

We got together a short while ago, had a session and planned out several additional treatment sessions due to a new condition that was a result of a medical procedure. All fine and well, right? Well, he cancelled via text message three days before the appointed next session. OK, these things happen – it is part of the nature of the business.

The problem comes in when it happens all too often. I used to get irritated and my little personality ego would puff up and I would think "well, I just won't work on him anymore!" Then he calls and needs another appointment, I agree, and this one he actually gets there and, lo and behold – on time!

So, how can I honor my commitment to provide a high-quality session when I get so darn miffed at him? I find myself going back and forth with do I give up on him and tell him I am done or do I see him again and try to set my anger aside?

There are as many different ways to look at this as there are practitioners. One thing is where are your boundaries? How far in advance do you need to be notified of a cancellation? What about a no-show? Personally, I need to set my boundaries and create a cancellation policy. This needs to be fair to me and to my clients.

Then there is the question of what is the highest and best for the client? Is there something we can help with if we give more time? Do we need to discuss the "being late issue?" Could there be a breakthrough? So many questions.

The clients "energy field, emotional, mental and spiritual can and will give us some clues we can use to help in our decision of what do I do with this person! Each client has different healing needs. What are their rays? What is best for you and your client? Can you give a high quality Esoteric Healing session?

For this particular client, through meditation I heard, "See him as a Soul and honor the Soul. His personality is afraid." I realize each session of Esoteric Healing helps in ways we might not see on a physical level but can sense benefit on another level. Hopefully with time a connection between his personality and Soul will develop. As long as I can focus on his Soul and leave my personality ego out of the picture, I will continue to accept working with this man – for the benefit of both of us. Alice Bailey writes in "From Bethlehem to Calvary," page 279, quoting Dr. Schweitzer:

"Civilization originates when men become inspired by a strong and clear determination to attain progress, and consecrate themselves, as a result of this determination, to the service of life and of the world. It is only in ethics that we can find the driving force for such action, transcending as it does, the limits of our own existence."

**Q:** I practice Esoteric Healing in Florida and many clients come to me for mold and allergy problems. How can I best support them?

**A.** Environmental issues are tricky for Esoteric Healers because if the mold, pollens, all possible irritants are not alleviated, the symptoms will return. Encourage your clients to consider negative influences, and implement what control they might have: salt water nasal rinses, clean foods and living space, scentless home products, an air filter.



After AAWOS, balance all the centers and their levels, do a general tune-up with emphasis on the adrenals, the liver, kidneys, all the cleansing organs, and the lymph if there is no history of cancer. Focus on the immune system. Do the allergy protocols, both for inhaled and ingested allergens, the sinuses, and address all information you get from their body, any signs of inflammation, irritation, etc.

Since the adrenals are involved in the airborne allergy protocol, keeping the adrenals from spiking is an important consciousness for alleviating dis-ease. Suggest meditation as a way to support homeostasis.

**Q:** I have a new client going through cancer treatment. It was originally in the breast, currently spots on the brain. She is married and still has a child at home. She is experiencing severe anxiety and called because she thought complimentary treatments would be helpful.

I did not perceive any space to suggest that she see her challenges as a spiritual journey, as well as a medical process. Her goal appeared to be about staying in the feelings with which she was familiar, and hoping for a magic cure, especially for her loneliness. I worked on her to the best of my ability but can't stop thinking about how to help. If she comes back, what protocols would you suggest I use?

**A.** She may be tethered to the physical, emotional, mental, and personality bodies, with no concept of a bigger lens. But she did get herself to a session and that indicates at least a need if not an openness.

Esoteric Healing is always done according to the will of the recipient's soul, and with the philosophy that disease is the sign of an inhibited soul life. Let them be reminders of your job and how to perform it. The challenge for you as the practitioner is clear: listen to her with your heart and integrate her soul as well as the energy of Spirit with the lower centers.

After balancing all levels of her chakras, systems (especially immune) the organs, glands, concentrating on anything affected by the toxicity of her medical treatments, you can work on the emotional and mental points in each of the centers. If you know Bonnie Dysinger's Anxiety Protocol, it would be helpful. The glamour and illusion points are useful, as is the courage to walk

through fears protocol. The higher centers balance will bring spiritual energy all the way down to the basic chakra. Do the petals of the soul, using the three basic Rays wherever appropriate.

Without explanation, just introducing the Rays of Will and Power (Ray 1), Active Intelligence (3), Love and Wisdom (2) into her energy field will in time create change. If she does return to you, suggest a meditation practice. Through her own willingness and EH sessions, eventually her soul light will begin to integrate with her lower chakras, her health, her feelings, her thoughts.
